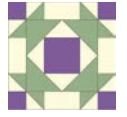

### Janet's Junk

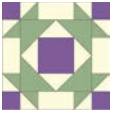

On August 6, 2019, President Janet Ferguson called the meeting to order and welcomed the members of the Shiner Heritage Quilters. There were 30 members in attendance.

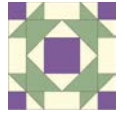
The Guild members recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

In new business, Janet Ferguson stated a Committee Chair is needed for the December Christmas Party. The discussion was tabled until the next meeting.

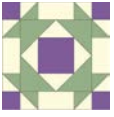
