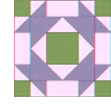

- If you have any ideas or suggestions for other programs, please let Kathleen know.

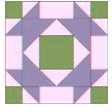
Hostesses for Upcoming Meetings

There will be no hostesses for the July meeting since we will be having our mid-year dinner.

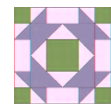
Janet's Junk

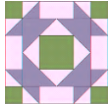
Old Business:

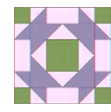
Janet once again reminded the members beginning in September the meetings would begin with the social hour at 5:00pm and the meeting would begin at 5:30pm

Bernadette reported she has five quilts ready to be delivered to nursing homes and Norma's House. She has about 40 quilt kits available at the meeting. She also reported during the last three months 14 quilts have been donated to Norma's House and nursing homes.

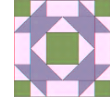
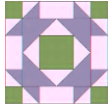
New Business:
