- **July:** Mid-year dinner. Date of meeting changed to **July 11th** due to 4th of July being meeting date.

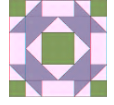
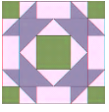

Janet presented the Meeting Minutes for the April 2023 meeting and asked if there were any corrections, and there were none. Rose Mary Havlik made a motion the April Meeting Minutes be approved, and Annette Meyer seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

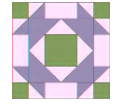
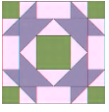
Rae Nell Janik presented the Treasure's Report for April 2023, and it will be filed for audit.

She said she and Linda had met and discovered that some of the books which were used in the past were missing and the ones found in the storage room needed to be updated. Janet will update the books and she and Linda will meet again to review the updates. Linda will then be able to meet with the group of quilt show chairs to start planning the show.

They reiterated that although the classes will take place Monday through Thursday, it is necessary that there be enough members present for each student to have a dedicated assistant. It is not necessary for members to sign up for the entire class schedule, but seven members need to be present to assist the up to seven attendees who will be participating in the classes.

Janet reminded everyone that June 6th is Bingo night, so remember to bring your cards and buttons with you to participate in the fun. She also said that members can work more than one card at a time and there will be prizes!

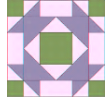
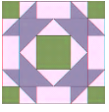
Janet said she will be taking quilts which members have made to Morgan's Wonderland soon and asked that the quilts be turned in to her for delivery.

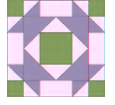
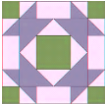
DONATIONS OF QUILTS TO NURSING HOMES AND NORMA'S HOUSE
